## PLAINTIFFS' APPLICATION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

Pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Local Rule 65(c), and supported by the Memorandum of Law and Declarations submitted herewith, Plaintiffs move for a preliminary injunction prohibiting Defendants from implementing President Trump's January 27, 2025 executive order (the "Order") effectively banning transgender people from serving in the United States Armed Forces. As required by Local Civil Rule 7(m), counsel for Plaintiffs conferred with counsel for Defendants on February 3, 2025. Defendants' counsel informed Plaintiffs' counsel that Defendants oppose the relief requested in this motion. For the reasons discussed in the accompanying Memorandum of Law, the Order violates Plaintiffs' rights to equal protection under the Fifth Amendment, and immediate injunctive relief is necessary to prevent Plaintiffs from suffering irreparable harm as a result of the Order. The specific relief sought herein is described in the accompanying Memorandum.

A proposed order granting injunctive relief is submitted with this motion.
